WALLABIES YOU CAN ADOPT

Waterfall Springs is currently involved in saving 4 species of wallaby that are threatened or endangered in Australia, the Brush-tailed Rock-wallaby (southern and central form), Bridled Nailtail Wallaby and the Yellow-footed Rock-wallaby.

We assist various state government recovery programs which are responsible for planning captive breeding programs and preparing safe wild habitats for the reintroduction of these animals.

Waterfall Springs Wildlife Sanctuary holds a National Parks and Wildlife Service general license to rescue and rehabilitate injured and orphaned Native Fauna providing suitable habitat, rehabilitation and care for their return to the wild. We offer education and assistance to local licensed wildlife groups.



ADOPT A BRIDLED NAILTAIL WALLABY

This small placid wallaby once occupied open scrubland from Vic to Central QLD but is now limited to one remaining wild population at Taunton QLD.

Thought to have become extinct, it was rediscovered at Idalia National Park in 1985 upon which the QLD Government organized a recovery team to ensure survival of the species.

Waterfall Springs Wildlife Sanctuary holds a small group of Bridled Nailtails as ambassadors for educational purposes to support the recovery process and to hold an insurance pool of genetics.



ADOPT A BRUSH-TAILED ROCK-WALLABY (BTRW)

A small reddish brown rock-wallaby weighing 5 to 8 kg with a characteristic long bushy tail and white cheek blazes. Living in steep rocky habitat the browse in the evening and early mornings, returning to their rocky shelters by day. This shy and beautiful animal was once abundant living throughout the Eastern ranges of Australia.

Through genetic research it has been determined there are 3 distinct forms of BTRW

- BTRW southern form (south eastern Vic, now extinct in ACT), critically endangered of extinction.
- BTRW central form (south eastern NSW), classified as endangered of extinction.
- BTRW northern form (north eastern NSW and south eastern QLD), vulnerable to extinction.



ADOPT A YELLOW-FOOTED ROCK-WALLABY

A beautifully coloured rock wallaby that was once common throughout western NSW, south western QLD and north eastern SA. Unfortunately it was hunted relentlessly for its attractive pelts. After the fur trade was outlawed the species suffered continued decline from predation by the fox and more recently competition for food and habitat by the rabbit and goat.

Today the species is classified as endangered with only a few small colonies remaining in the wild.

The South Australian government has commissioned a Recovery Team to re-establish a secure future for the species. Waterfall Springs holds a group of approximately 20 Yellow-footed Rock-wallabies for community education and to support the SA recovery program.



ADOPT AN ORPHAN FROM THE NURSERY (Minimum amount to adopt \$300)

Injured and orphaned native fauna that is found locally are regularly handed in to the sanctuary and hand raised alongside joeys from our threatened species.

Fauna such as wallabies, kangaroos, wombats, possums, gliders, echidnas, birds, bandicoots and non-venomous reptile's etcetera are cared for here at the sanctuary by trained staff and volunteers utilizing our purpose built wallaby nursery and vet room facilities.

By sponsoring a joey in the nursery facility you will receive regular updates of its progress. School groups raising more than the \$300 adoption fee will be able to personally name their joey.
